Turner Reservoir (aka Falls Creek Ranch Lake)



Turner Reservoir is one of Falls Creek Ranch's greatest assets. Our 40-acre lake is fed by Falls Creek, which funnels snowmelt downstream from the mountains above FCR. Wildlife can be viewed in abundance in/on the lake and along the hilly, forested shoreline.



FCR's Lake Committee monitors and manages the health of the lake and oversees recreational usage of the lake (including, but not limited to, addressing water quality concerns, maintaining beaches and rafts, overseeing recreational issues, stocking fish, and establishing boating and fishing guidelines). This private lake is for the exclusive use of FCR residents and their guests. Our residents enjoy year-round use of the lake and its beaches, including swimming, non-motorized boating, paddleboarding, fishing, ice-skating, cross-country skiing, snowshoeing, and relaxing and playing on our sandy beaches. Neighborhood get-togethers are often hosted at the lake, where picnic tables and a propane grill are available. The lake is stocked with fish as needed.
